Chapter meeting

The SW chapter meeting was held at Taunton on 9th November 206 covering Benign Proctology. The theme of the day was proposed by the local trainees at the previous meeting and expressed their wishes to learn about benign procedures. There were 27 attendees and the day was chaired by Mr Paul Mackie from TAUNTON and included video demonstration of managing haemorrhoids, anal fissure and fistula. In addition, endoscopic management of benign rectal polyps was comprehensively covered by Rupert Pullan (EMR and ESD), and Paul Lidder (TEM). The trainee rep (Ken Keogh) and the nurse rep (Christina Berry) also took part in the meeting and Ken covered the literature review of managing haemorrhoids. The topic and timing of the next meeting was also discussed with the delegates and it was agreed to cover colorectal cancer for the next meeting which will include CNS session. It was decided the next meeting to be in November (date TBC). In addition to the support from ACPGBI, the meeting was supported by 5 sponsors and we broke even.
