Role of the International Representative:

- 1. To establish links with other Societies throughout the world.
- 2. To establish and enhance links with ESCP, ICC and ASCRS.
- 3. To be responsible for organising overseas travelling fellowships (USA and Australia/New Zealand).
- 4. To be responsible for the selection of the British Travelling fellow.
- 5. To host the two European Fellows and arrange the programme.
- 6. To report and attend Council and attend other relevant meetings.
