Participants are asked to submit an essay on the following subject:

"What would Lord Lister have thought of the Shape of Training recommendations regarding the future of NHS surgical training and patient care?" (Word limit: 2500)

Judging criteria are (weighting %):

- Knowledge of Lister in terms of relevance to the question (50%)
- Readability & grammar (25%)
- Originality (25%)
