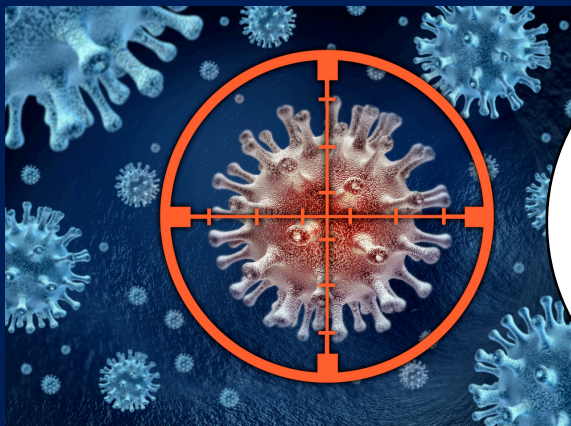
Dr Phil O'Connell
