DAY 1 CONTENT:

- The damage control philosophy.
- Left anterolateral thoracotomy.
- Clamshell thoracotomy.
- Repair of atrial and ventricular injuries.
- Median sternotomy.
- Control of vessels.
- Thoracic and oesophageal trauma.
- Radiology of trauma.
- Approaches to the hilum, pulmonary injuries superior and posterior mediastinum.
- Closure and drains.
- The military approach to major trauma.
- Abdominal approach: The international experience

DAY 2 CONTENT:

- Pre-peritoneal packing (pelvic trauma).
- Supraceliac aortic control.
- Splenectomy.
- Pringle manoeuvre.
- Liver mobilisation/packing.
- Exposure of femoral, iliac, popliteal vessels.
- Major vascular lower body injury.
- Kocherisation, pancreatic injury.
- RtoL visceral medial rotation/IVC repair.
- LtoR visceral medial rotation; renal repair & nephrectomy.
