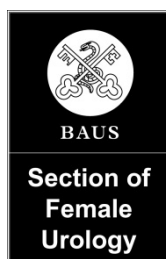

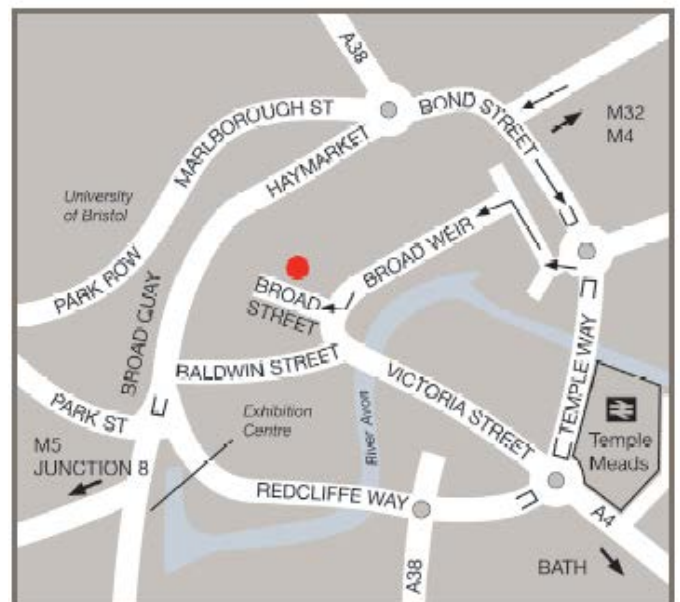
Bristol Temple Meads station is 1 mile from the hotel

7. We will let you know if your abstract has been accepted or rejected by **Friday 30<sup>th</sup> August 2013**. All correspondence will be with the named presenter at the address given.
8. The presenting author whose abstract is accepted must register to attend the meeting and pay the registration fee. Failure to do so will result in exclusion from the final programme.
