

Pelvic Floor Disorders Course

This course is designed for all healthcare professionals starting and or undertaking endoanal or total pelvic floor ultrasound (transperineal, transvaginal) scanning. It provides comprehensive instruction on performing and interpreting endoanal, transperineal, and transvaginal scans. Additionally, the programme covers the treatment of bowel dysfunction including rectal irrigation, sacral neuromodulation and both nurse and physiotherapy led approaches to bowel, bladder and vaginal dysfunction.

Attendees will have the opportunity to hear from experts at Guy's and St Thomas' on anatomy, obstetric injury, clinical assessments of the pelvic floor as well as take part in practical work stations each day.

This course is suitable for consultant surgeons, physicians, clinical nurse specialists, clinical scientists, GI physiologists, pelvic floor physiotherapists and registrars – all from urology, uro-gynaecology and colorectal backgrounds.
